The **Port of Shelton Board of Commissioners** announces a vacancy for **Position No. 1**.

Port of Shelton commissioners serve as part of a three-member governing body setting policy and budget for the district. Key responsibilities include the management of an appointed director, adoption of annual budgets including tax levies, and property management. The Commission are expected to attend two regular monthly meetings, other community meetings as necessary and statewide conferences requiring some travel for an approximate monthly commitment of 8-12 hours. **Candidates must be registered voters and reside in the port district.**
